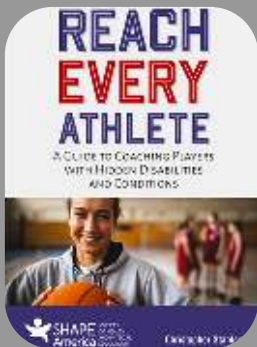

## Reach Every Athlete: A Guide to Coaching Players with Hidden Disabilities

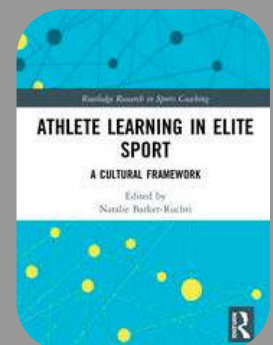
